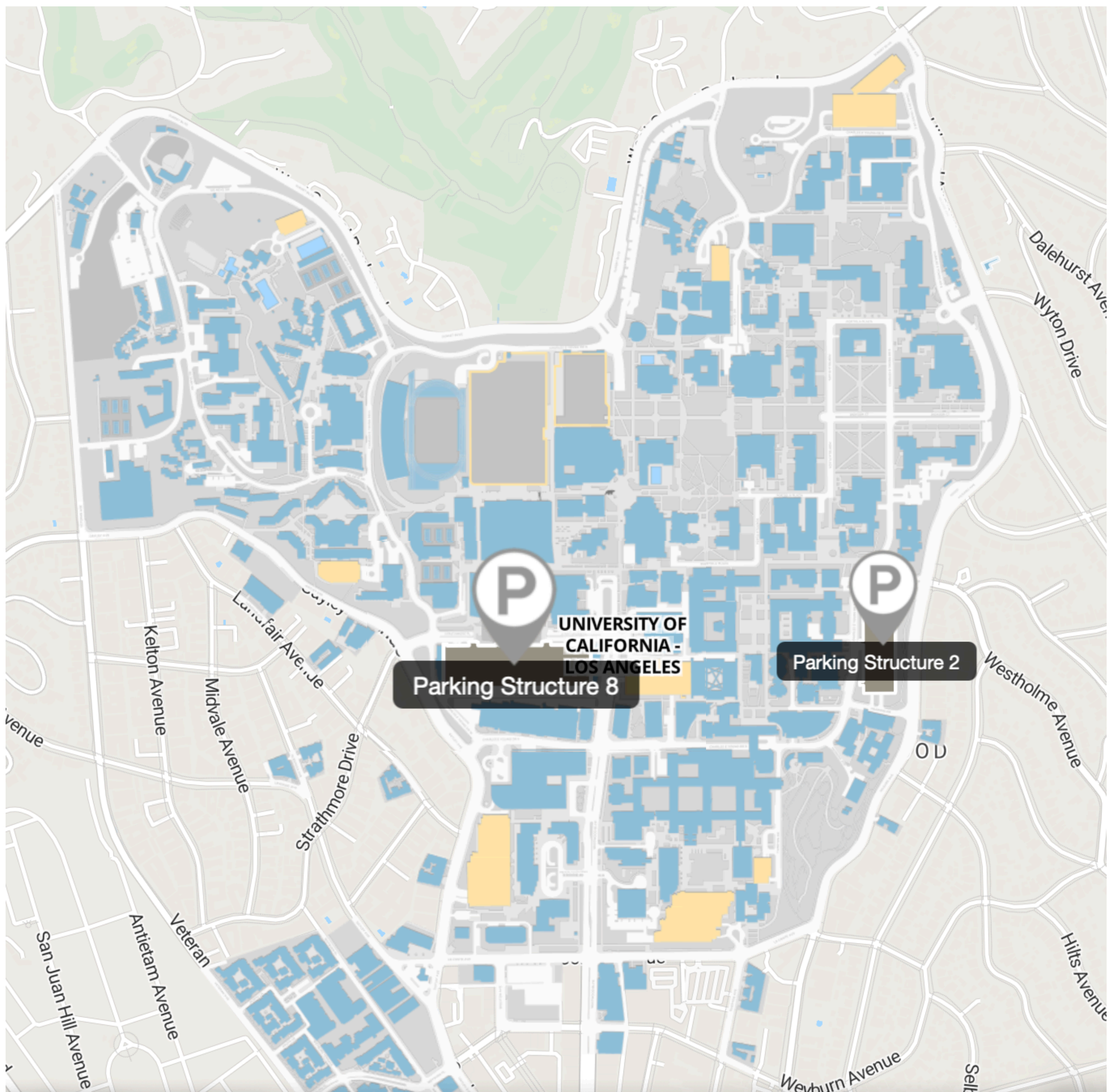

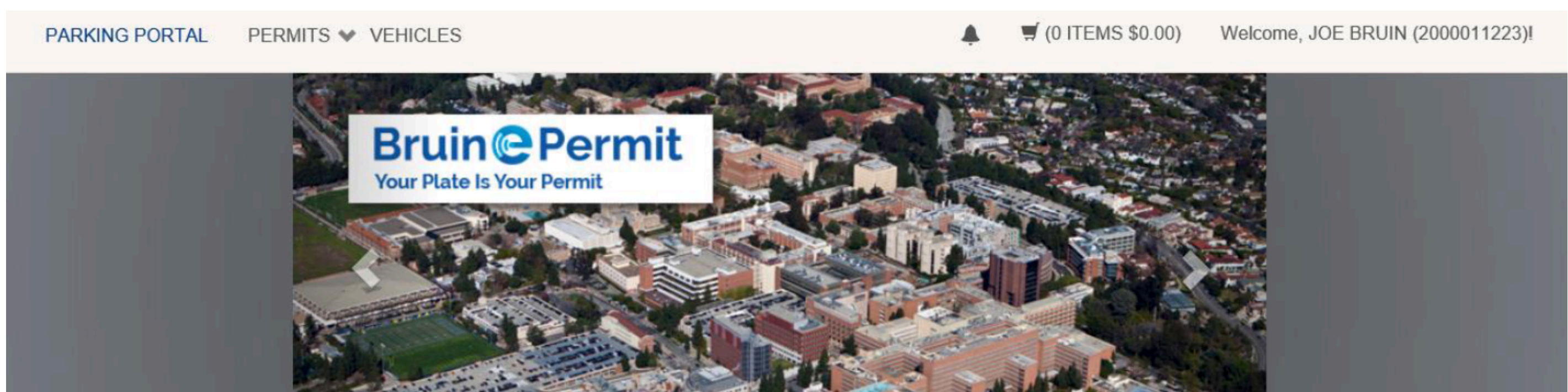

Parking Information

For UC Employees Visiting UCLA

In order to obtain reciprocity, faculty and staff must upload proof of their home campus permit and a valid UC ID to the [Bruin ePermit Portal](#). For instructions, please refer to this [step-by-step guide](#).



For non-UC Employees

To purchase visitor parking at the pay station, follow the steps below:



1. All self-service pay stations use pay-by-plate technology.
2. Once parked, go to the nearest parking pay station.
3. Enter your license plate number.
 - a. If you do not have a license plate number, please enter the last 6 (six) digits of your Vehicle ID Number (VIN).
 - b. Your VIN can be found on the driver's side door or the lower driver's side of the windshield.
4. Choose the amount of time that you would like to spend on campus.
5. Pay using the exact cash amount or with a credit card.
 - a. Pay stations do not provide change.
 - b. There are no refunds for pay station purchases.

For those using their VIN, please place your receipt on your dashboard, otherwise nothing else is required.

Directions to the Collaboratory



This is the exterior of Lot 2, located near William G. Young Hall. Across from Lot 2 is Young Hall, where the venue is located.

This is the exterior of William G. Young Hall across from Lot 2. Continue straight toward the double doors ahead to access the main hallway inside.



Enter through the double doors of Young Hall to reach the first floor. Once inside, continue straight down the hallway to reach the elevators on your right.

At the first-floor elevator area, take the elevator up to the fourth floor.



Directions to the Collaboratory



Upon exiting the elevator on the fourth floor, turn right and walk down the main hallway. Continue until you reach the intersection where two hallways cross.

At the intersection of the main hallway and the cross hallway, you'll see an overhead sign directing you toward the Dongwoon Yoo Seminar and Conference Hall (Room 4222). Turn right at this intersection to continue toward the Collab.



After turning right at the intersection, proceed straight down the hallway. Continue walking past the offices and rooms on either side until you reach the Collab, located toward the end of the corridor on your right.

You've made it to the Collab! This collaborative space is located on the fourth floor of Young Hall, designed for meetings, projects, and creative work. Welcome!
